## Letter from the Council President

*Covenant.* This word represents a formal agreement, a promise based on relationships and coming together with one another. On Sunday, January 2<sup>nd</sup>, St. John's elected 2022 Council members were officially installed. We were recognized and took an oath, a covenant, to support the Church, St. John's congregation, and its mission to share God's love and do His good works with and for our community.

During our January Council meeting, Council pledged our covenant to God, to each other as Council members, and to each of you as members of our St. John's community. While no relationship is perfect, we promise to do our best in each moment to strengthen and support our relationships. We promise to listen, not just hear, the congregation's hopes and needs for the future of the Church. We aim to see each of you and meet you where you are in your journey. We will hold you in our prayers—always. And we invite you to join us in this covenant and to build with us a community that overflows with God's love.

Council began work on strengthening our relationships and how we can best support the congregation and its ministries, including the appointment of Council liaisons for St. John's ministry teams and the establishment of a small, short-term committee charged with examining opportunities for growth and areas of focus for the upcoming year and beyond. We ask for your prayers as we finalize establish a solid foundation from which we work through necessary revisions to St. John's constitution and by-laws that will be presented for congregational review this spring.

And on behalf of Council, we extend our gratitude for the Call Committee and their dedication to this process to find the best pastoral candidate for St. John's. We share in the excitement to move forward in the call process for a new pastor at St. John's as I'm sure each of you do as well.

Please know how immensely important the congregation's involvement is in this process. As mentioned in the newsletter, announcements in church, and the letter mailed to your homes, we invite you to contact the Church Office at 410-665-1234 to confirm your participation in the pastor candidate "meet and greet" on Saturday, February 5<sup>th</sup> at either 3 p.m. or 7 p.m. at the church. The pastoral candidate will be preaching the next day, Sunday, February 6<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m. with a special congregational meeting immediately following the worship service. Additional details, especially for those who plan to join us virtually, will be provided upon calling the Church Office.

As always, many blessings to you and yours this upcoming month. We look forward to seeing you in church and joining you in fellowship as we celebrate God's love and covenant with us as children in Christ.

## Caring Friends Ministry

“In all this I have given you as an example that by such work we must support the weak remembering the words of our Lord Jesus, for He Himself said, ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive’”. Acts 20:35

Caring Friends is a ministry of outreach to all members, family members and friends of St. John’s Lutheran Church in Parkville, MD. It was created in 2010 as an opportunity for church members to reach out to those who cannot for whatever reason always attend the many worship and fellowship celebrations offered as a church community. This ministry includes phone calls, personal visits from the Pastor, Deacon, and/or Eucharistic Ministers, prayer, gifts made by the youth, prayer shawls and prayer blankets, baptismal blankets, monthly newsletters, weekly service bulletins and announcements and Christmas, Easter, Birthday and Get Well cards throughout the year.

Included in this ministry are the Pastor, Deacon, and eight (8) active commissioned lay Eucharistic Ministers who visit and take Communion to our homebound members, their families, caregivers and others, usually monthly or as often as requested. Our visits take us to private homes, hospitals, hospice and rehabilitation facilities, senior living facilities, and nursing homes.

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and the ruling of sheltering in place, facility lockdowns and limited visitations, Interim Pastors, the Deacon and Eucharistic Ministers have visited and/or taken communion to the homebound over 125 times this year sometimes on the front porch or on the back porch or patio. On Ash Wednesday of 2021 we received a request from Brightview Senior Living for someone to come to impose ashes. Deacon Claire took ashes to 30 residents and staff at Brightview White Marsh and since then we have been visiting with a communion service for the residents and staff of about 20 to 30 people each month. Homebound members continue to receive phone calls and will continue to receive them as needed. This ministry also assists with requests from the Church Council and Church Secretary as needed.

As an OSSD Deacon and Pastoral Assistant, I will continue my service representing Christ through the action of the Holy Spirit, set apart for a ministry of mercy, service, and outreach and accept other duties as assigned by the Pastor and/or the Church Council that will help further God’s Mission and Ministry at St. John’s and beyond. If you are interested in being a part of this wonderful ministry, please contact Deacon Claire.




