Come to the table of mercy, prepared with the wine and the bread. All who are hungry and thirsty, come, and your souls will be fed. Come at the Lord's invitation; receive from his nail-scarred hand. Eat of the bread of salvation; drink of the blood of the Lamb. –Evangelical Lutheran Worship Hymn #481

In the weeks that follow Easter Sunday, we hear so many stories in the Gospels about people encountering the risen Christ.

--This includes the disciples on the road to Emmaus. The group that gathered for Wednesday night worship after the April Community Meal heard this from Luke chapter 24:

<sup>32</sup>They said to each other, 'Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?' <sup>33</sup>That same hour they got up and returned to Jerusalem; and they found the eleven and their companions gathered together. <sup>34</sup>They were saying, 'The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon!' <sup>35</sup>Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he had been made known to them in the breaking of the bread."

In their encounter with Jesus, his presence is revealed to them as he teaches them and breaks bread with them.

We surely encounter Christ's presence in similar ways:

-when we gather around the word, which we hear in scripture, sermon, song, creed, and prayer.

-when we gather around the table to share this same meal, where Christ gives himself to us and we hear these powerful words, "given for you" and "shed for you."

These encounters around word and sacrament are at the very center of our faith, and the life of the church.

In these Easter weeks leading up to Pentecost, we can especially notice them as places where we encounter the risen Christ.


### **Men-in-Mission**


### Wednesday Night Worship May 1<sup>st</sup> after the Community Meal 6:45 pm




### St. John's Youth Group meets in the Youth Room


