Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

**Christ has died.**

**Christ is risen.**

**Christ will come again.**

Each Sunday, as we gather at Christ's table, we speak these words together. And each year, at this sacred time, we are drawn once more into their meaning—into Holy Week.

Most people only experience Easter Sunday, but the story begins long before the empty tomb.

Palm Sunday leads us into Holy Week and into the great Three Days of Jesus' passion and resurrection—the very heart of the Christian faith.

On Maundy Thursday, Jesus gathers with his disciples for the Last Supper. He washes their feet and gives them a new commandment: love one another as I have loved you. We will share in a meal together at 6:00 pm, followed by Holy Communion at 7:00 pm.

On Good Friday, Jesus is crucified by the powers of empire. In the face of fear and violence, he does not turn away, but freely lays down his life for the world he loves.

On Easter Sunday, God raises Jesus from the dead, opening the way to new and everlasting life for all. We are invited to live as God's new creation—people of hope, children of the Resurrection.

This is your invitation to experience these Three Days with us. To enter the mystery, to be shaped by the good news of a God who loves us to the end.

# Notes from the Organ Bench



Alleluia! Christ is risen!

It feels so good to be able to say Alleluia without worrying someone may hear you. How do you teach a handbell piece during Lent without saying the word when one of the hymns is “Jesus Christ is Risen Today”? But as Simon said during the Children’s sermon, “If you say it, it’s okay. You don’t have to cry.” Alleluia!

April is here with, hopefully, warm weather, gentle rains, and plenty of sunshine. April brings trees blooming, birds singing and making nests, and flowers beginning to sprout. Since the first Easter came after the Passover feast, it must happen in the spring. What better time? Pastor Amy’s Alleluia caterpillar will burst from its box (I am hoping as a butterfly) in the same mysterious way that Jesus burst from the tomb.

Did you know that you cannot help a butterfly escape the chrysalis? It must do it on its own. If assistance is given the butterfly will die. It needs that struggle to build the wing strength necessary to live. Our life is very similar. The challenges we face help to build our character, self-confidence, and faith. Of course, we do get plenty of assistance on our journey.

One of my favorite hymns is “Now the Green Blade Rises.”  
(Text: John MacLeod Campbell Crum, 1872-1958; © Oxford University Press)

*Now the green blade rises from the buried grain, wheat that in dark earth many days has lain; love lives again, that with the dead has been; love is come again like wheat arising green.*

*In the grave they laid him, love by hatred slain, thinking that he would never wake again, laid in the earth like grain that sleeps unseen; love is come again like wheat arising green.*

*Forth he came at Easter like the risen grain, he that for three days in the grave had lain; raised from the dead, my living Lord is seen; love is come again like wheat arising green.*

*When our hearts are wintry, grieving, or in pain, your touch can call us back to life again, fields of our hearts that dead and bare have been; love is come again like wheat arising green.*

This is spring! This is Easter! After the struggle comes new life!

Now that Easter is here, I need to express my thanks to many people. The Adult and Handbell Choirs deserve many thanks for their music during Lent and Easter. Though members of the groups are dealing with life and health problems, they continue to make a joyful noise! Many thanks to them for their dedication. Many thanks to the worship leaders who assisted with the Holden Evening Prayer services. Thanks also to Yoon-Mee Chong for sharing her incredible gift of music. Thanks also to Andy and Linda Gaylor for lending their voices on Good Friday for *We Remember Calvary*. St. John’s is very blessed.

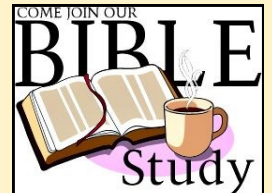
